Working as part of a multidisciplinary design team, LPDA provided comprehensive master planning (A Services), detailed design services (B Services) and construction support services (C Services) for the Army National Guard Readiness Center (ArNG) Addition Project at Arlington Hall. As a result of the 2005 Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC), key elements of the ArNG and the National Guard Bureau Joint Command, currently located in leased space in Crystal City, Virginia, will be relocated to a new facility at Arlington Hall, Virginia.

The new Headquarters and Readiness Center, an approximately 193,000 SF addition, included: Workstation programming, Audio/Visual, Command Section Delta, Directorate Training Area, Conference Room Support, parking garage, hardscape and landscaping, intensive roof garden and terrace, with extensive site modifications, utility redesign and underground storm water systems. Because of the limited site, AT/FP force protection measures and hardening of portions of the facility were required. The facility achieved LEED-NC Gold certification.
