A left over industrial lot, constrained with environmental features and steep slopes, became the focus of Lynchburg Parks and Recreation’s mission to create a community park with a sustainable and socially inclusive program.

LPDA led a multidisciplinary team to provide programming, environmental documentation, design, construction documentation, and construction administration for this unique park. Our process addressed site technical issues as well as community needs.

Phase one included picnic shelters, pervious parking, a future nature center, universally-accessible trails, wetland observation walk, fishing pier, native plantings and the adaptive reuse of a historic log cabin for offices and canoe rentals. Graphic sections and sketches included plans and elevations of park architectural elements and signs. LPDA managed a prioritization and construction documentation process which resulted in finished product which met the City’s budget and program requirements.
